The Year 12 formal school-based assessment program is to reflect the following requirements:

- a maximum of four assessment tasks
- the minimum weighting for an individual task is 10%
- the maximum weighting for an individual task is 40%
- one task must be based on a fieldwork activity with a weighting of 20-30%
- only one task may be a formal written examination with a maximum weighting of 30%.
